Ezekial 18:14, 17b-18, 21, 27-28, 30-32

<sup>14</sup> "But suppose this son has a son who sees all the sins his father commits, and though he sees them, he does not do such things:

<sup>17b</sup>He keeps my laws and follows my decrees.

He will not die for his father's sin; he will surely live. <sup>18</sup>But his father will die for his own sin, because he practiced extortion, robbed his brother and did what was wrong among his people. <sup>21</sup> "But if a wicked person turns away from all the sins they have committed and keeps all my decrees and does what is just and right, that person will surely live; they will not die. <sup>27</sup>But if a wicked person turns away from the wickedness they have committed and does what is just and right, they will save their life. <sup>28</sup>Because they consider all the offenses they have committed and turn away from them, that person will surely live; they will not die.
